Dear Parents and Guardians,

The Spring Term in Pheasant Class has started with a flourish of activity and we have a number of trips and outings over the next week, so I thought it might be helpful to send a quick overview of what is happening to avoid any confusion:

Friday 10th January: We will be driving the children (by minibus and car) to Chichester Free School for singing rehearsal tomorrow. This will all happen within the school morning and so this trip does not have any impact on lunches, drop-off or pick-up.

Tuesday 13th January: We will be walking to the Chichester Festival Theatre to attend the Children's Concert. The weather currently looks clear so we will hopefully not need to make any last minute changes to the plan. Children will need to be wearing comfortable footwear to walk in, and a warm coat. There will likely be a number of children outside the theatre after the event so <u>pick-up</u> will be outside the Minerva Theatre (across from the main <u>building</u>) at 2:45pm.

Wednesday 14th January – Daytime: We will be transporting the children to the theatre (after registration in the morning) by car for final rehearsals. All children will need <u>a packed lunch</u> and their school water bottle. <u>Pick-up will then be at 2:30pm outside the Minerva Theatre</u>.

Wednesday 14th January – Evening: It seems there has been a bit of a mix-up with timings for the concert itself. I have had confirmation that <u>children need to be at the theatre for 6pm (we will meet outside the Minerva Theatre at this time)</u> so that they are ready and in their places for the singing to begin at 6:45pm (not 7pm as previously stated). For those who didn't manage to purchase a ticket in the first round of sales, further tickets have now been released and are available on the CFT website.

Some children have already been provided with a coloured T-Shirt (which could probably do with a quick iron if at all possible), and those who have not, will be given a T-Shirt early next week. This should be worn alongside black trousers or leggings and school shoes. T-Shirts can then be returned to school after the event so that we have a full class set for future use.

Pick-up after the United Voices concert will be at 8pm outside the Minerva theatre.
